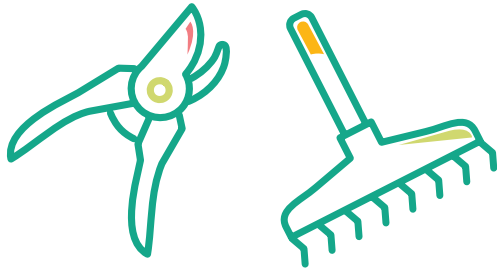




SEASONAL TREE CARE MUSTS YOUR SPRING CHECKLIST

Plan for a happy, healthy growing season.

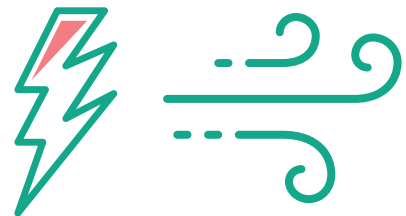


CLEAN UP

- Remove dead and high-risk trees
- Prune dead, diseased or unsafe branches
- Shape shrubs, cut back perennials, clean up leaves and debris from planting beds.

PREPARE

- Consider lightning protection in advance of spring storms

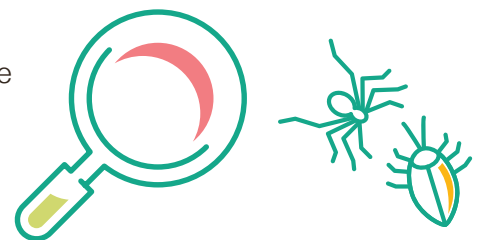


SOIL CARE

- Freshen your planting beds with new mulch (3-4 inches maximum)
- Fertilize trees, shrubs and lawn
- Inspect and repair irrigation system to ensure good soil moisture management

INSPECT

- Inspect trees and shrubs for standing water or flood damage
- Inspect trees and shrubs for overwintering pests and mushrooms/diseases
- Apply preventative insect/disease treatments as advised by your certified arborist
